Women's History Month is a month-long celebration, observed annually in March, during which we reflect upon women's contributions to history, culture, and society in the United States, under a theme selected by the National Women's History Alliance. This year's theme – "Moving Forward Together! Women Educating & Inspiring Generations" - spotlights the contributions women have made to the American educational system, the free marketplace of ideas, and the very fabric of our democracy. From classrooms to boardrooms, and from grassroots movements to global initiatives, women educators and leaders have played a pivotal role in nurturing minds and inspiring transformative action.

As part of the preparations for Women's History Month, the Delaware County Women's Commission (DCWC), is excited to seek nominations for this year's DCWC Annual Awards. At our annual brunch, on March 29th, the DCWC will honor three women (current or past county residents) who have dedicated their lives to education, mentorship, and leadership. Nominations can be made in one of three categories:

- **Woman of Distinction** (Past) - Honors the memory of a deceased female leader
- **Woman of Achievement** (Present) - Honors a current female visionary leader
- **Woman of Inspiration** (Future) - Honors a young woman already making a difference today, under the age of 45 years old.
