PY 2025 CDBG Program Application - Municipal with Low- and Moderate-Income Areas

Delaware County Council has initiated planning for the Program Year (PY) 2025 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The County anticipates receiving approximately \$3 million in the upcoming program year, which is scheduled to begin on July 1, 2025.

Those interested in applying for funding must forward an application package to the Delaware County Office of Housing and Community Development (OHCD) no later than 4:30 p.m., Friday, January 3, 2025.

All CDBG Application forms and instructions are available at www.delcopa.gov/hcd/cdbgapplication.html Please note that forms requiring initial/signatures must be printed, signed and **original copies are required**. OHCD recommends that applicants use the <u>Application Checklist</u> to ensure that all relevant forms and documentation are submitted. Incomplete submissions will not be considered for funding.

## Please note the following:

- The low/mod income summary data that supports the CDBG National Objective of providing benefit to lowand moderate-income persons on an area basis was updated August 1, 2024. Please use the updated data set as provided in the enclosed map.
- Applicants awarded PY 25 CDBG funding are <u>required</u> to attend an OHCD-approved Fair Housing Training during the program year. Failure to do so will impact future eligibility for CDBG funding.
- Applicants are strongly encouraged to attend the Submitting a Successful CDBG Application webinar via Microsoft TEAMS on November 14, 2024. - Municipalities are required to hold at least one Public Hearing prior to applying.
  - Public notice must be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality no less than ten (10) days prior to the proposed hearing. The notice must identify the date, time, place and purpose of the proposed hearing. Meeting minutes and an Approved Resolution must be submitted with the application.
- Municipal applicants are responsible for all project Engineering, Design and Inspection costs related to public improvements. These costs serve as the required Municipal match.
- Applicants may submit one (1) Primary Application and one (1) Alternate Application.
- Applicants seeking funding for Acquisition/Relocation activities must contact OHCD to schedule a Pre-Application meeting before proceeding.

There are several on-going countywide housing programs available. Please refer to the included Municipal Demolition Program flyer and the OHCD website for additional resources available.
