Liquid Waste Haulers Data / Pumping Management Program

Delaware County Health Department (DCHD) is excited to announce the start of the Liquid Waste Haulers Data / Pumping history Management & Reporting Program. This program will run in conjunction with our Liquid Waste Haulers Program and focus on reporting of all pumping activity performed on any Onlot Wastewater Treatment System in Delaware County.

The purpose of the Data Management program is:

- To provide a resource for municipalities to research / review reported history, frequency and activities performed on their properties.
- To monitor potential areas regarding ACT 537 planning.

This program will collect valuable data and information like number of gallons pumped, the general condition of the tank and if anything out of the ordinary was noticed by the pumper. This information will then be shared with Municipal Leaders and other Community Planners to help them in ACT 537 planning and initiatives.
