#### Questions and Answers on Magisterial District Judge Certificate of Nomination

- 1. What is an Incumbent Magisterial District Judge Certificate of Nomination?
  - a. The Incumbent Magisterial District Judge Certificate of Nomination (IMDJCN) is a means for an elected incumbent Magisterial District Judge to access the ballot of the primary election without gathering signatures.
  - b. The IMDJCN is established by Section 912.1(32) of the PA Election Code, 25 P.S. § 2872.1(32), which was enacted into law by Act 127 of 2018 on October 24, 2018.
  - c. The language of Act 127 of 2018 is available online at <a href="https://www.legis.state.pa.us/cfdocs/Legis/LI/uconsCheck.cfm?txtType=HTM&yr=2018">https://www.legis.state.pa.us/cfdocs/Legis/LI/uconsCheck.cfm?txtType=HTM&yr=2018</a> &sessInd=0&smthLwInd=0&act=127.
- 2. Is this the same as the "other" certificate of nomination that has existed for many years?
  - a. No. Certificates of nomination are issued under the Election Code's Article IX(E), 25 P.S. §§ 2953-60, to fill vacancies caused by death or withdrawal of a candidate, and are used to submit a candidate's name for a November election or a special election. They are like the IMDJCN only in that no voters' signatures must be gathered.
  - b. The IMDJCN is used to submit a candidate's name for the primary election, and only for an incumbent magisterial district judge running for re-election. (An incumbent magisterial district judge serving by appointment of the Governor may **not** file an IMDJCN, but must circulate and file nomination petitions in the same manner as any other non-incumbent candidate.)
- 3. When filing for re-election, what other documents must incumbent magisterial district judges submit besides the certificate?
  - a. The General Assembly in Act 127 did not specify the requirements for filing in detail, but the Department of State understands the IMDJCN to take the place of the nomination petition only.
  - b. Other candidate filing requirements established by the Election Code remain in effect, including:
    - i. Candidate's Affidavit,
    - ii. Filing Fee,
    - iii. Statement of Financial Interest, and
    - iv. Campaign Finance Filing Requirements or Waiver of Expense Account reporting Affidavit.
- 4. What is the deadline for filing these documents?
  - a. The Department of State understands the deadline for filing the IMDJCN to be the same as the deadline for filing nomination petitions.
  - b. For other required documents and filings, their respective deadlines continue to apply.
- 5. What about third parties?
  - a. Act 127 addresses only nomination petitions and access to the ballot for the primary election, which by law is conducted only for the nomination of candidates by the "major" political parties (*i.e.*, the Republican and Democratic parties currently).
  - b. Act 127 does not appear to grant any privileged ballot access to incumbent magisterial district judges who seek the nomination of a minor political party or a political body. An incumbent magisterial district judge who seeks re-election as the candidate of a minor political party or political body must, like any other such candidate, gather signatures through nomination papers as provided in Section 912.2 and Article IX(B) of the Election Code, 25 P.S. §§ 2872.2, 2911-14.

- 1. The Delaware County Bureau of Elections is the supervisor for elections of county and local level offices, candidates seeking state office must contact Pennsylvania Department of State.
- 2. The name as printed on item #2 of the Incumbent Magisterial District Judge Nomination Certificate is the name that will appear on the ballot, example: legal name of person is Joseph P. Smith, Jr. but wishes name to appear on the ballot as Joe Smith, Jr.
- 3. Nicknames (not derivatives of your legal name) may not be printed on ballots.
- 4. The <u>complete mailing address of the candidate must be legibly printed</u> on item #3 and #4. Be certain to list post office where mail is to be sent on #3 and the city, borough or township of residence on #4. The post office may be Broomall but township is Marple or post office may be Bryn Mawr but Township is Radnor

Example: John T. Doe 123 Main Street, Broomall (Marple Twp) PA 19008

- 5. Do not include a social security number on the Nomination Certificate affidavits, SS: is a legal symbol for Sworn and Subscribed to **not** Social Security Number. Note that Nomination Certificates and all attachments are public record.
- 6. All forms must be notarized before filing with the Bureau of Elections.
- 7. Candidates who **Do Not** sign the **Waiver of Expense** Account Reporting Affidavit are **required** to file candidate statements or reports according to the Campaign Finance Calendar. Blank statements and reports can be obtained from this office upon request or may be downloaded from our website. Failure to file reports in a timely manner will result in costly fines.
- 8. If the office you are filing for requires a filing fee, the payment is made in with the Delaware County Treasurer's Office prior to filing the nomination certificate in the Bureau of Elections. If the Statement of Financial Interest Form indicates the <u>ORIGINAL</u> filing shall be "filed with the County...." In Delaware County the office in reference is the County Clerk's Office, located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor.
- 11. If you wish to retain copies of your Nomination Petition for your records, make them prior to filing the petitions in the Bureau. If you request copies of your Nomination Petitions in the Bureau a fee of .25\$ per page will be charged. Due to time management copies will be completed within 24 hours. NOTE: All dates are **subject to change** without notice in the event of passage of any amendatory legislation.

<sup>\*\*</sup>For your report to be accepted as timely filed, you must postmark your report at least one day prior to the filing deadline.

<sup>\*\*</sup>Your notarized cover page **must be received in our office** ten calendar days (including weekends) after the filing deadline. Postmarks will **not** be accepted.

<u>SIXTH TUESDAY PRE-PRIMARY or PRE-ELECTION REPORTS</u> are required to be filed *only* by candidates for <u>statewide</u> office, their authorized candidate committees, and any political committee or lobbyist that has made an expenditure to influence the election of a <u>statewide</u> candidate. In 2021, <u>statewide</u> offices appearing on the ballot include the following:

### JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT JUDGE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT JUDGE OF THE COMMONWEALTH COURT

Political committees/lobbyists that have <u>not</u> made an expenditure to influence the election of a candidate for the statewide offices listed above do not need to file the Sixth Tuesday Pre Primary/Election report.

<u>SECOND FRIDAY PRE</u>- and <u>THIRTY DAY POST-PRIMARY or ELECTION REPORTS</u> are required to be filed by all candidates appearing on the ballot and all political committees and lobbyists that have made expenditures to influence the election of such candidates. In 2021, offices appearing on the ballot include:

JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT

JUDGE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT

JUDGE OF THE COMMONWEALTH COURT

JUDGE OF THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS

JUDGE OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT (PHILADELPHIA COUNTY)

ALL LOCAL/MUNICIPAL OFFICES (FILE WITH APPROPRIATE COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS)

<u>ANNUAL REPORTS</u> must be filed by *all* candidates, political committees and contributing lobbyists that have not filed a termination report.

\*\*SPECIAL ELECTIONS\*\* - In the event of any special election, candidates and committees should contact our bureau regarding reporting requirements and filing deadlines. A separate report will need to be filed for each Special Election Cycle. Special Elections do not follow the reporting dates for Cycles 1-7. Information regarding Special Election reporting dates can be found on our website.

**PENALTIES** - In accordance with the Campaign Finance Reporting Law, those who file required reports after the filing deadline are assessed a late filing fee of \$20 per day for the first six days that a report is late, and \$10 per day thereafter, up to a maximum penalty of \$250.

**NOTARIZED COVER PAGES** - The Department allows ten (10) calendar days for the notarized cover page to be received in our office before the report is marked late. In the event that the notarized cover page is not received timely, a late fee will be assessed *from the date of the report filing deadline*. The Department does not accept postmarks for the cover pages.

**POLITICAL COMMITTEE TREASURERS** - It is the treasurer's responsibility to file required committee reports. Keep this schedule available for reference prior to each reporting deadline. If you need a reporting form, you may print one from the Department's <u>website</u> or request one from the bureau. You may also file your report online. From the website, select the link to Campaign Finance and then to Online Filing for more information. Please remember that all <u>reports must include your filer identification number</u> on the cover page.

24 HOUR REPORTING - Section 1628 of the Campaign Expense Reporting Law, 25 P.S. § 3248, requires any candidate or political committee, authorized by a candidate and created solely for the purpose of influencing an election on behalf of that candidate, which receives any contribution or pledge of five hundred dollars (\$500) or more, or any person making an independent expenditure of five hundred dollars (\$500) or more after the final pre-election/pre-primary report has been deemed completed shall report such contribution or expenditure to the appropriate supervisor. The candidate, chairperson or treasurer of the political committee shall send the report of late contributions within twenty-four (24) hours of receipt of the contribution. The same shall apply to persons making independent expenditures. The bureau will accept the filing of 24 Hour Reports by facsimile at 717-705-0721, via e-mail at: ra-stcampaignfinance@pa.gov or online. The filing of reports by facsimile or e-mail applies only to 24 Hour Reports; it does not apply to the filing of campaign finance reports. The filing of late contribution reports does not remove the obligation to also report those contributions on the appropriate post-election/post-primary expense report filing. Please contact our office for specific reporting dates for late contribution reports.

CANDIDATE DECLARATION to be attached to CANDIDATE'S AFFIDAVIT on Nomination Petition where notarized statement is not available

This form is for use by local candidates filing in Delaware County Bureau of Elections as well as for State candidates filing in Harrisburg. Use of this form in Delaware County is limited at this time to 2021 Primary filing of Nomination Petitions and may not be acceptable beyond COVID protocols.

<u>CANDIDATE DECLARATION</u> - I declare that my residence, my election district and the title of the office for which I desire to be a candidate are as contained in the attached document, that I am eligible for said office, that I will not knowingly violate any election law or any law regulating and limiting nomination and election expenses, and prohibiting corrupt practices in connection therewith; that I am aware of the provisions of Section 1626 of the Pennsylvania Election Code requiring pre-election and post-election reporting of campaign contributions and expenditures; that unless I am a candidate for Judge of a Court of Common Pleas, the Philadelphia Municipal Court or the office of school board in a district where that office is elective or the office of magisterial district judge, my name has not been presented as a candidate by nomination petitions of any other party for the same office; that if I am a candidate for any office of a political party I am a registered and enrolled member of such party; that if I am a candidate for Committee Delegate or Alternate Delegate to the National Convention the name of the candidate to whom I am committed is as indicated on my nomination petition and that my signature on the Delegate's Statement was affixed to each page of my nomination petition prior to circulation of same; that I am not a candidate for an office which I already hold, the term of which is not set to expire on the same year as the office subject to the accompanying affidavit.
