This is an unofficial notice of the General Election to be conducted on November 5, 2024, in Delaware County. You may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA), available at <a href="www.votespa.com">www.fvap.gov</a>. You may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to a Primary or Election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB). Military electors may also use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

You may use the FWAB to vote for a candidate for President of the United States, U.S. Senator and U.S. Representative (Representative in Congress) as well as candidates for all state and local\_offices, and ballot initiatives.

To vote, fill out and send in the **Voter Information Page** (page 2) and **Official Backup Ballot** (page 3) of the FWAB.

- To vote for President of the United States, U.S. Senate (U.S. Senator) and U.S Representative (Representative in Congress) write in the name of the candidate in the space provided on the FWAB.
- To vote for state and local offices or for ballot initiatives write the names of candidates or the ballot initiative in the appropriate section of the FWAB.
  - Under the **Office/Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the office the candidate is running for or the title of the Ballot Initiative (referendum).
  - Under the Candidate Name, Party Affiliation or Initiative Vote heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for, or if you are voting on a Referendum question write "yes" or "no."

Should a majority of those voting on the question vote in opposition thereof, then licenses for the sale of liquor will not be granted to applicants in Upland Borough.
